have kids

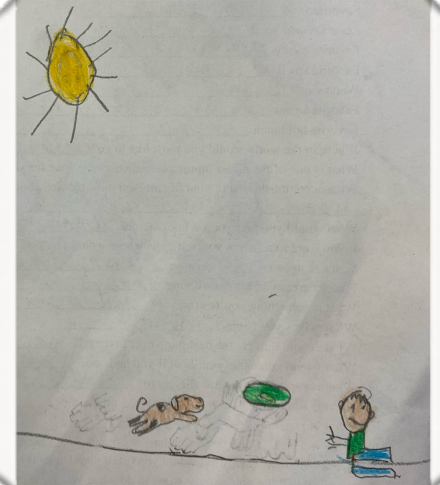
As a parent, my top three rules
