If I were a teacher, I'd teach my students: play anything

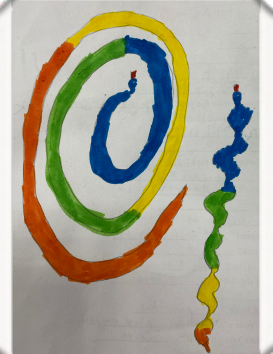
When I grow up, I can't wait to: drive
