### Mission Fair & Mission Gree

Thank you to everyone who supported this year's mission fair and the mission projects. By the Saturday evening of the fair, including offerings that came in at church as well, a total of \$4,282 was given. Of that, \$600 has been sent to provide warm blankets (Swiss Army blankets) for those enduring the war in Ukraine. This project is being carried out by Outpost Centers International, a ministry that networks and nurtures hundreds of Adventist supporting ministries around the world. Ostap Dzyndra (who was here last year for Week of Prayer) is involved with getting these blankets to help people stay warm. \$3,682 of the proceeds was sent to help complete the building of the church in Guatemala which is now fully funded. 
