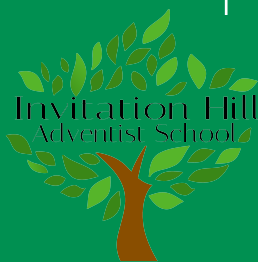

summer went away all too soon.*

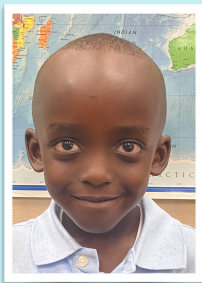
*Outside you smell the autumn scents;
