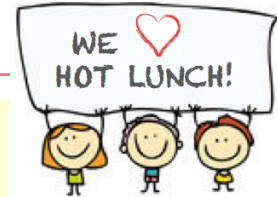
Happy Hearts Banquet

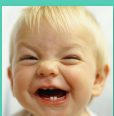
